



Burntisland Golf House Club (BGHC) Child Protection Policy 2025/2026

BGHC is committed to safeguarding the welfare of all children in its care. These guidelines are based on the following principles:

- The welfare and protection of children are the primary concerns.
- All children have the right to protection from all forms of harm and abuse.
- Children have the right to express views on all matters that affect them.
- BGHC will work with children, parents and staff to promote the welfare, health and development of children.

BGHC will:

- Promote the health and welfare of children through playing golf safely.
- Respect and promote the rights, wishes and feelings of children.
- Promote and implement procedures to safeguard the well being of children and protect them from abuse.
- Recruit, train, support and supervise its staff, members and volunteers to adopt best practice to safeguard and protect children from abuse and to reduce risk to themselves.
- Require staff, members and volunteers to adopt and abide by this Child Protection Policy and these procedures.
- Respond immediately to any allegations of misconduct or abuse of children.
- Regularly monitor and evaluate this Policy and these procedures.

This Policy and Procedures will be regularly reviewed (at least every 3 years):

- In accordance with changes in legislation and guidance on the protection of children or following any changes within the organisation.
- Following any issues, or concerns raised about the protection of children within BGHC.
